



## NOAA Center for Weather and Climate Prediction

### Driving

- **From Maryland:**  
Take I-495 East to exit 23A (Kenilworth Ave/MD-201 S). Stay on 201 S and make a right onto River Rd. Take the 1st right onto University Research Court. The NCWCP building is at the end of the cul-de-sac on the left side.
- **From Virginia:**  
Merge onto I-495 OUTERLOOP/Capital Beltway/ toward Alexandria. Take the I-295 N/National Harbor exit, EXIT 2A-B, toward Washington. Keep right to take DC-295 N toward US-50 E (crossing into Maryland stay in Middle lane) to 201 North Kenilworth Ave). Turn left onto River Rd. Take the 1st right onto University Research Court. The NCWCP building is at the end of the cul-de-sac on the left side.
- **From Washington, DC:**  
Take I-295 North (Middle lane) to 201 North Kenilworth Ave. (Cross East-West Hwy/MD-410) left onto River Rd. Take the 1st right onto University Research Court. The NCWCP building is at the end of the cul-de-sac on the left side.

### Parking

NCWCP provides free, on-campus parking for tenants and small visiting groups. Individuals with NOAA issued badges must stop and present their badge at the access control reader at vehicle entry gate before proceeding. Any individual without an access badge must obtain clearance from the security guard stationed at the entry gate prior to driving onto campus. Individuals entering the security perimeter on foot may be asked for identification prior to being permitted onto campus. For parking and specific facility access guidance, please contact your event organizer. All persons wishing to enter the facility must present a valid, government-issued photo ID.

### Metro

The NCWCP is accessible via the Green or Yellow Line to the College Park/University of Maryland station. It is a 15-20 minute walk (to the east down River Road) from the station to the NCWCP. A shuttle is also available during peak commute periods.
